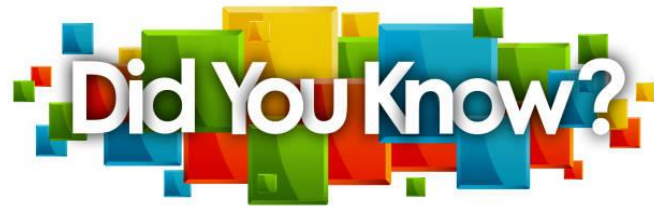
Updating our cover photo – Redland Bay Ladies Golf
